



BURNABLE TRASH	<p>Always tie a trash bags.</p> <p>◎Put in the specified trash bags.</p>	<p>KITCHEN SCRAPS</p> <p>The vegetable waste and the leftover come from kitchen and so on.</p> <p>◎Drain liquid completely</p>	<p>PLASTICS</p> <p>CD, Cassete and video tapes, plastic bags and others.</p>	<p>COOKING OIL</p> <p>◎ Stuff milk carton with newspaper to absorb oil.</p>	<p>PAPER WASTES</p> <p>Tissue paper, disposal diaper, sanitary napkins, pet litter.</p> <p>◎ Flush stool in toilet.</p>	<p>LEAVES and LIMBS</p> <p>Do not mix leaves, limbs, with other wastes.</p> <p>◎Tie or put in specified trash bags. OVERSIZED TRASH	<p>Acceptable trash</p> <p>Oversized furniture etc.</p> <p>Bicycles, Three wheel vehicle</p> <p>Small size home electronics etc.</p>	<p>● When carrying in a oversized trash, the processing ticket is necessary.</p> <p>○ The processing ticket: It can be bought at Environment Section of Kin Town office and each district office. (Processing ticket can be bought at the day duty of Kin Town Office and trash treatment field office on Saturday and holiday.)</p> <p>● The oversized trash needs a processing ticket for every piece.</p> <p>● Carry in a oversized trash respectively to the processing plant.</p> <p>● When trash contained a lot of vegetation kinds (Handles as the oversized trash) can be carrying-in to Kin Town Processing Plant with truck by purchasing ticket.</p> <p>● TV, freezer, refrigerator, air-conditioner, washing machine and aundry drier (due to Electric Appliance Recycling Law), and PC, industrial waste (tire and construction trash and so on) etc. can not be carried in.</p> <p>Kin Town Trash Processing Plant (Nakagawa-District) Carrying Time: Every day (8:30AM-5:00PM)</p> <p>※During Jan 1st to 3rd and typhoon period (Storm warning announcing time), it isn't possible to carry in the trash.</p>
